# ULTRACOAT HT SPORT

Two-component water-based polyurethane lacquer for wooden sports floors







#### WHERE TO USE

**Ultracoat HT Sport** is a two-component water-based polyurethane lacquer for sportive wooden floors. **Ultracoat HT Sport** has the same technical characteristics of a standard two-component water-based lacquer; it has been formulated in order to meet the highest requirements for wooden sports floors. **Ultracoat HT Sport** conforms with European standards for indoor multisports surfaces meeting EN 14904:2006 requirements. Hardness, chemical and mechanical resistances make **Ultracoat HT Sport** a highly reliable product.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

- Do not use, transport and store **Ultracoat HT Sport** at temperatures below +10°C or higher than +25°C.
- Not suitable for outdoor application.
- Use only clean containers and tools.
- Use in combination with Ultracoat Premium Base.
- Completely remove all traces of previous treatements in order to achieve an even finish.
- Protect treated surfaces from direct sunlight and draughts for the first three hours after application.
- Do not put surplus quantities of the product back into its original container. Partially used containers must not be stored for very long.
- At high temperatures, we recommend diluting the product up to 10% (Dir. 2004/42/CEE) with water or **Ultracoat EL**.

#### Preparation of the product

Mix thoroughly component A with component B until completely blended. At high temperatures, dilute comp. A before mixing with comp. B with up to 10% of clean water or **Ultracoat EL** (Dir. 2004/42/CEE). Once blended it is advisable to wait a few minutes before starting the application.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Sand wooden floors with coarse and medium-grained sand paper and vacuum all traces of dust. Grout cracks and irregularities in the surface with **Ultracoat Aqua Plus** or **Ultracoat Binder** according to the instructions contained in the product's TDS. Remove all traces of dust after buffing.



Apply a first even coat of **Ultracoat Premium Base** by **Ultracoat Roller Sport Base**. After 12 hours buff the surface with **Ultracoat SR 180/220** abrasive disk and proceed with the application of a first coat of **Ultracoat HT Sport** by **Ultracoat Roller Sport Finish**.

After 12-24 hours buff the surface with **Ultracoat SR 220** abrasive disk. If necessary, apply line and court markings applying one or more coats of **Ultracoat Sport Color**, (according to the instructions contained in the product TDS) and apply the final coat of **Ultracoat HT Sport**.

# CLEANING

Clean tools and remove residues of **Ultracoat HT Sport** with water while the product is still fresh. Once hardened the product may only be removed mechanically.

## CONSUMPTION

80-100 ml/m² per coat.

## PACKAGING

5 + 0.5 l per unit (A+B).

#### STORAGE

12 months in its original, sealed packaging in a dry place.
